**DECISION OF THE TAUPO DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

**The Application**

This is an application by **Catherine Mackintosh on b/h of BOP U13 Rep Hockey Team** for an On-Site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the **BOP Under 13 Girls Hockey Quiz Night**. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 29th August 2019.

**Reasons for the Decision**

The applicant appears to be a suitable entity to hold an alcohol licence and a certificated manager will be overseeing the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

The reports of the Police and the Medical Officer of Health do not oppose this application.

**The Decision**


I am satisfied that the criteria of Section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 have been satisfactorily addressed by the applicant and the licence may issue subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Friday 27 September 2019 from 7.00pm to 11.00pm.**
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,

- b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises,
- c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty,
- d. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.

The licensed premises known as the Acacia Bay Hall, 2 Wakeman Road, Taupo, is more precisely identified as outlined in the event site plan provided with the application, as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 30 August 2019.

## **Taupo District Licensing Committee Special Licence – On Site**

*Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Catherine Mackintosh on b/h of BOP U13 Rep Hockey Team** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at Acacia Bay Hall, 2 Wakeman Road, Taupo, and known as Acacia Bay Hall, 2 Wakeman Road, Taupo for consumption on the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **BOP Under 13 Girls Hockey Quiz Night**.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

### **Conditions:**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: **Friday 27 September 2019 from 7.00pm to 11.00pm**.
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
