The Application

This is an application by Equestrian Sports New Zealand Incorporated for an on site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the A series of separate events. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 9th February 2024.

Reasons for the Decision

The applicant appears to be a responsible entity to hold a Special Licence and a certificated manager will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health reports raise no matters in opposition.

On Site Special Licence

Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Equestrian Sports New Zealand Incorporated** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 114 Rapids Road, Taupo and known as National Equestrian Centre - indoor bar area for consumption on the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **A series of separate events.**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: **Wednesday 20 March 2024 to Friday 22 March 2024 – from 5.00pm to 8.00pm on each date (Dressage NZ National Championships). Saturday 30 March to Monday 1 April 2024 – from 4.00pm to 10.00pm on each date (Easter Indoor Championships); Thursday 4 April 2024 to Friday 5 April 2024 – from 4.00pm to 10.00pm on both dates; Saturday 6 April 2024 from 6.00pm to 12.00 midnight (Jumping NZ Series Final Competition). Thursday 9 May 2024 to Saturday 11 May 2024 – from 4.00pm to 8.00pm on each date (NZ National Eventing Championships).**
2. The bar area is designated as a Supervised area, as identified on the plan date stamped as received by Taupo District Licensing Committee on 9 February 2024.
3. A maximum of two alcoholic drinks can be sold to any one person at any one time.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard
7. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages
8. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises,
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty,
 - d. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.

DURATION

This licence is only in force as specified in Condition 1.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The licensed premises known as the National Equestrian Centre Taupo situated at 114 Rapids Road, Aratiatia, RD 2, Taupo, is more precisely identified as outlined in the event site plan provided with the application as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 9 February 2024.
